2009-2010 WASDA BERT GROVER CHILD ADVOCACY AWARD

The Wisconsin Association of School District Administrators (WASDA) has set a priority of advocating for the welfare of Wisconsin youth. One effort is to recognize either individual or organizations who do this in an exceptional way. At this time, WASDA members are requested to please submit nominations for recognition through the WASDA Bert Grover Child Advocacy Award program.

CRITERIA

1. Individuals or organizations can be nominated. WASDA members, Honorary Life WASDA members and current or past educators will not be considered as candidates. (*Preference will be given to those individuals or organizations outside of the education community.*)
2. Nominations must be made by a WASDA member.
3. The individual or organization must have demonstrated strong concern for children.
4. All nominations must be received by the WASDA Child Advocacy Committee on or before **FEBRUARY 5, 2010**. They should be forwarded to Ron Welch, Chair, Child Advocacy Committee, School District of Algoma, 1715 Division Street, Algoma, WI 54201.
5. The WASDA Child Advocacy Committee will evaluate the nominations and make a recommendation to the WASDA Executive Board. The WASDA Bert Grover Child Advocacy Award will be presented at the WASDA Annual Educational Conference in the spring.
6. All nominees for the WASDA Bert Grover Child Advocacy Award will receive a WASDA Certificate of Recognition. WASDA members submitting nominations will be responsible for presenting these Recognition Certificates to the individuals they have nominated. The WASDA Child Advocacy Committee will assist in this procedure.
